Division Chief Barry Parker Promoted to Assistant Fire Chief of the Support Services Bureau

Ventura County, CA – Surrounded by his family and colleagues at headquarters, Division Chief Barry Parker was honored for his well-earned promotion to Assistant Fire Chief of the Support Services Bureau.

Parker's promotion marks a significant milestone in his distinguished 30-year career.
